The 1st PLVB® Workshop: Sustainability in Practice was held online on February 25, 2021, between 9 am and 12:30 am, with the participation of 22 representatives from 10 member companies. The event was also attended by the international guest and keynote speaker, Suzane Greene - manager of the Sustainable Supply Chain program of the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) - who presented how the practice of sustainability in supply chains is promoting a global transformation in logistical practices. As part of the technical content, there was a discussion about the definition of concepts

and critical success factors to obtain sustainability applied from the insertion of new attributes and performance measurement of the three pillars of sustainability. As for practical application, the steps for creating the sustainability plan, ways to go, benefits to be obtained, strategic, tactical, and operational actions and best practices were presented, following the Reference Guide "Best Practices for Freight Transport", published by IBTS in 2017 under PLVB®'s scope.
