### CARBON MARKET, an opportunity to be conquered

The 3<sup>rd</sup> PLVB<sup>®</sup> Workshop: Correlation between Sustainability and Operating Costs was held online on June 24, 2021. Twelve representatives from 24 member companies and Prof. Luan Santos from both (i) the Production Engineering Program (PEP/ COPPE/UFRJ) and (ii) the Faculty of Administration and Accounting Sciences (FACC/ UFRJ), who highlighted the role of finance and sustainable investments in promoting logistics and supply chain management less carbon-intensive. The workshop began with a contextualization on sustainability and climate change, followed by the presentation of market solutions related to carbon pricing (carbon markets and carbon taxes) and main lessons and good practices from international experiences. Then, an overview of the Brazilian reality was presented, with a focus on the logistics and transport sectors, highlighting its potential in achieving the goals of reducing greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions within the scope of the Brazilian`s NDC, from the Paris`s Agreement and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), as well as the opportunities arising from carbon pricing and other financial mechanisms such as green bonds.
