

## PLVB® once again present at the Sustainable Transport Forum

Present at the 2<sup>nd</sup> Edition of the Sustainable Transport Forum, on October 14, 2021, PLVB® participated this time in two panels. The 1st panel, coordinated by Prof. Lino Marujo discussed sustainable practices for smart cities, with the participation of specialists on the subject such as Ieda Oliveira (Elatrabus), Sílvia Barcik (Itaú) and Sofia Figueiredo (Veolia). The 2<sup>nd</sup> panel entitled “New energy matrix: energy solutions for the energy matrix of transport”, under the coordination of Prof. Márcio D’Agosto, was attended by specialists from ABVE (Adalberto Maluf), ABIOGAS (Gabriel Kropsch), Comgas (Guilherme

Feitas), APROBIO (Júlio Mineli) and Seara (Jonas Rabello). Solutions were presented and discussed to reduce the dependence of transport on the use of diesel oil derived from petroleum, such as biodiesel, biogas, natural gas and electricity. In this context, Seara's experience with the use of electric trucks for the urban distribution of frozen cargo and the potential of using natural gas and biogas for medium-distance cargo transfer stands out. This discussion confirms the importance of the actions of the PLVB® with the creation of a Technical Committee on the energy matrix for transport in 2022.

## New companies join the PLVB®



Blau, Nivea and Jadlog are the newest members of the PLVB® to arrive in full force. At a meeting with the PLVB Coordination, the actions of Blau in promoting good practices in the use of vehicles with greater energy efficiency and

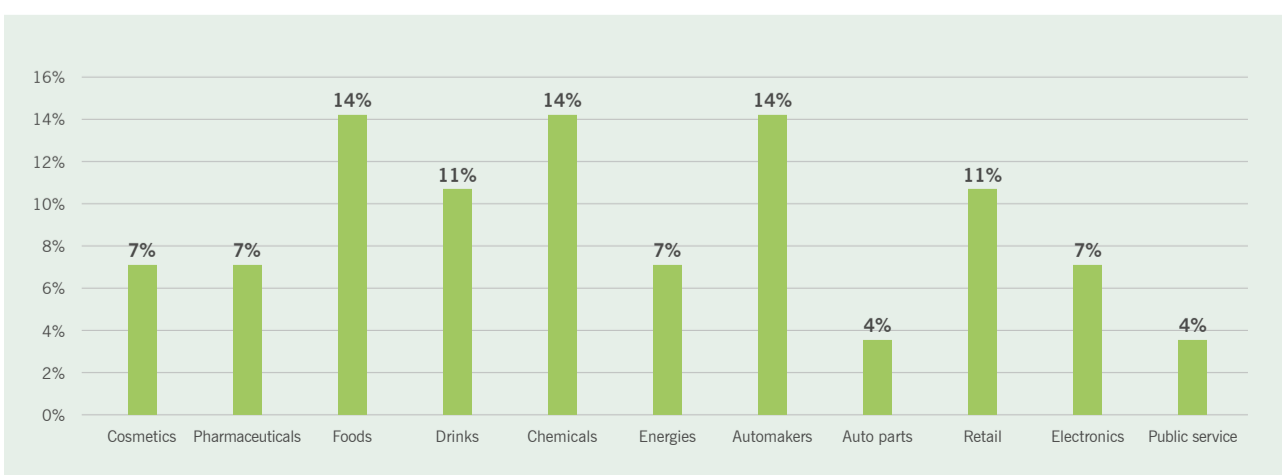
cleaner energy sources, through the use of electric trucks, were discussed, which is also a reality for Jadlog, which still has urban deliveries by tricycles. Nivea has the prospect of initiating actions for projects to use biogas. Another company that returns

to PLVB® to continue playing a leading role in sustainability in logistics is Cargo Polo. With this, the number of member companies of the Program is expanded and renewed, multiplying the scope of their actions.

Over its 5 years of existence, PLVB® has produced, shared and disseminated applied knowledge about sustainability in supply chains in 11 economic activity segments, represented by 28 shipping companies operating in the cosmetics, pharmaceuticals, food, beverage, chemical, energy, automakers, auto
